

Flyover along NH 4-A to take off soon

Panaji: The construction of a flyover connecting Old Goa and Panaji along the NH 4A route will be taken up soon. The foundation stone for the 11km-flyover will be laid on September 29, said PWD minister Ramkrishna (Sudin) Dhavalikar.

"The flyover, which is expected to cost ₹163 crore will have a separate scooter lane on both sides of the bridge," he said, adding that only after this project gets completed other projects related to highways will be taken up.

The PWD minister informed that he has instructed officers to complete road repairs by October end, adding that the repair work on Taleigao road will be taken up from November 15. He also said that the Panaji road repairs will be completed before Iffl 2014. TNN
